Stained glass windows

There are some amazing old stained glass windows at The Arts Centre. Can you create some stained glass windows designs of your own at home these holidays?



- Baking paper, lining paper, newsprint or another semi-transparent surface
- A regular pencil
- Coloured pencils or pens

- Black Sharpie, black pen or black coloured pencil









ONE WAY OF DOING IT (YOU MIGHT HAVE ANOTHER!)

- 1. Draw your unique design lightly onto a piece of baking paper, lining paper or newsprint with a pencil
- 2. Use coloured pens or pencils to colour in the shapes you have drawn, right up to their edges (blocks of colour work best)
- 3. Use a black Sharpie, pencil or pen to thicken the pencil lines that separate the coloured sections, and around the outside of your design
- 4. Cut out your design with scissors
- 5. Hold your creation up to your window and let the light shine through the colours!
