WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Magazine pages, junk mail, old books, wrapping paper, postcards, photos etc • PVA glue and brush, or glue stick
- Plain paper to stick images to

STEP 1:

Select and cut out images from magazines, junk mail, postcards

Arrange the images on your blank paper until you are happy with your design.

STEP 3:

Glue down your images to your paper using a glue stick or PVA glue and brush.

• Felt pens, crayons or coloured pencils

STEP 4:

Add details to your design with felt pens, crayons or coloured pencils. Ka pai to mahi, well done!
